### **Call for Abstracts**

***Abstract Deadline: April 30<sup>th</sup> 2010***

Contributions from both research and clinical fields across any discipline are welcome.

Abstracts can be submitted for one of three types of presentation:

- Oral presentation (20 min)
- Poster
- Workshop (90 or 45 min)

Abstracts should be submitted in English. More than one abstract may be submitted. Abstract content must not exceed 250 words (include word count). Do not include figures, tables or references.

All Abstracts should include:

1. Title of Presentation
2. Name, qualification, discipline & affiliation of each author
3. Contact email address

## **Oral Presentations and Posters**

Oral presentations should be of 20 minutes duration (15 minute presentations & 5 minute discussion).

There will be concurrent sessions and we hope to group papers together around the themes below.

Presentations involving current patients will normally not be accepted due to ethical reasons.

Please note that papers to be presented will be selected by the abstract selection committee. Papers not selected for oral presentation might be given the option of poster presentation instead.

All abstracts of selected papers and posters will be printed in the programme.

- Please indicate preferred topic for papers:
  - Treatment
  - Research and evaluation
  - Service delivery
  - Prevention
  - Consumer /carer initiatives
  - General/other

## **Workshops**

Workshops will be run in concurrent sessions and should focus on clinical issues. Along with the abstract please include aims, contributions from each presenter (maximum of 3) and time allocated for discussions.

- Please indicate preferred format:
  - 90 minute duration including a minimum of 30 minutes discussion
  - 45 minute duration including a minimum of 15 minutes discussion
