



ANZAED/AED ICED EARLY INVESTIGATOR TRAVEL SCHOLARSHIPS 2022

Award Support

1. Two awards will be provided in 2022. As ICED2022 is to be held as a hybrid event, the form the award takes will depend on whether the winner/(s) elect to attend in person or virtually. First and second placed award winners will not need to elect the same mode of attendance.
2. For winner/(s) who elect to attend in person:
 - a. ANZAED will provide a 1st prize of up to AUD\$2,000 for travel expenses to the AED ICED and AED will provide full conference and research training day registration plus an invitation to the AED Mentor/Mentee Breakfast for the awardee.
 - b. ANZAED will provide a 2nd prize of up to \$A1,000 for travel expenses to the AED ICED and AED will provide full conference and research training day registration plus an invitation to the AED Mentor/Mentee Breakfast for the awardee.
3. For winner/(s) who elect to attend virtually:
 - a. ANZAED will provide a 1st prize of AUD\$2,000.00 as a research stipend to be administered by the applicant's University or workplace. AED will provide full conference registration.
 - b. ANZAED will provide a of AUD\$1,000.00 as a research stipend to be administered by the applicant's University or workplace. AED will provide full conference registration.

Eligibility

1. Applicants must be members of ANZAED.
2. Applicants must be honours/ fourth year students, postgraduate students, or within three years of fourth-year or postgraduate degree.
3. Applicants must have abstract(s) (poster and/or oral) accepted for presentation for which they are the first author at the upcoming AED International Conference on Eating Disorders
4. An applicant cannot have previously received either the AED /ANZAED award in years past or first prize in the AED/ANZAED award from 2020 onwards. Applicants may also have applied for a different AED Travel Fellowship but may only accept ONE such award from ANZAED/AED in 2021/2022.
5. Applicants may not be current members of the ANZAED Executive Committee.



Application Materials

1. Applicants must submit their accepted abstract(s), a curriculum vitae and a letter from his/her training program or document verifying status as a young investigator (as defined above).
2. Applicants must submit, a personal statement (of no more than 500 words) address the following **Selection Criteria**
 - i. The quality, significance and innovativeness of the research you will be presenting at ICED;
 - ii. Their potential to make a significant contribution to the field of eating disorder research; and
 - iii. The impact that this Scholarship will have on their future research training/career.
3. These materials will be submitted to anzaed@anzaed.org.au by 5 pm AEDT time Monday 10 January, 2022.

Selection Procedures

1. Eligibility, including ANZAED membership status, will be verified by ANZAED prior to the full review of applications.
2. Eligible applications will be reviewed by a panel of reviewers, selected by the ANZAED Executive Committee. The panel will score the applications according to the Selection Criteria. The two top-ranked applications will be sent to the ANZAED Executive Committee and AED Scientific and Awards Committee for approval.
3. Applicants will be advised of the outcome before the end of February, 2022.
